The 2024 Coffs Craft Carnival November 23rd proudly held at Coffs Harbour SLSC, 23 Surf Club Rd.

With over 500 competitors, 50 officials, and 1,000 spectators, the event is shaping up to showcase action packed competition at Park Beach in Coffs Harbour.

POWER CRAFT

A Power craft Roster will be in place for the safety of competitors.

TIMETABLES

The full timetables will be available in 'Documents' Stack Team App.

FEES

Late entry fees will apply after 9th November.

MERCHANDISE

Official Event Merchandise: Delfina, Jolyn, Finis, Race One and Aquatic Angels are Official Merchant partners for the carnival. Traditional Craft Carnival merchandise can be purchased from live heats on entry. The lawn area outside Coffs Harbour SLSC will host merchant stores.

TEAM APP

Team App: Stack Team App will be used throughout the carnival as a platform to communicate important information and timetable changes to Officials, Team Managers, and Competitors.

To receive live event updates, participants can download the "Stack Team App" application and join the "Coffs Craft Carnival 2024" group. A live results page can be accessed via Liveheats.

LIVE HEATS

Liveheats: The Coffs Club will be implementing the Liveheats carnival management system for marshalling, recording results, and calculating the overall point score. Competitors must bring their Live Heats wristbands, which must be allocated prior to the start of competition. Additional wristbands can be requested from SLSNC at an additional cost.

SAFETY

Hi Visibility Lycra vests are mandatory for all competitors to wear throughout the carnival.

ENVIRONMENT

Location Specific Details: The Craft Carnival will be hosted in Coffs Harbour with the support of City of Coffs Harbour. The sand dunes at Park Beach are an important ecological feature, and access to the competition site should only be through designated pathways. Mesh fencing will be in place to deter individuals from accessing the dunes. Competitors and officials are encouraged to leave no evidence of human impact and respect the off-limit areas.

TIDES

It is expected that the tide will be going low in the morning.

HANDLERS

Only one handler per competitor is permitted in the arena. The spectator area is located behind the competition arenas.

WARM UPS

The warm-up schedule includes a swim session from 7:00 am to 7:20 am and a craft session from 7:20 am to 7:40 am. Competitors must wear a pink high-visibility rash vest during warm-ups, and warm-ups should not commence before 7 am.

BBQ

Coffs Harbour SLSC has a BBQ available at the clubhouse, which will be running on the

Voucher & Prize Collection - Voucher draws will take place on the beach after discipline finals are complete. - All vouchers and prizes must be collected at the carnival.

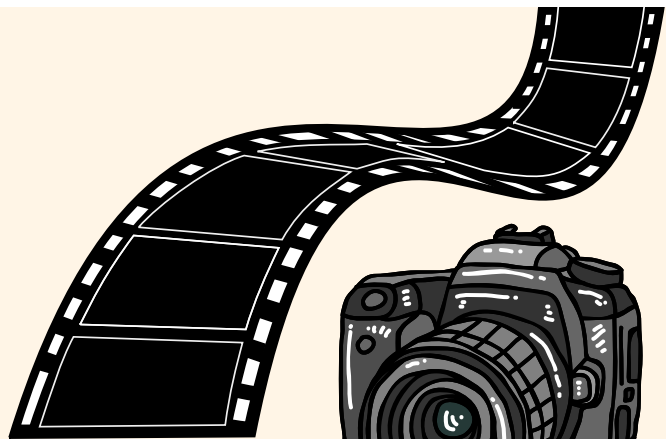
